

Rules and Regulations of the 2026 Czesław Cybulski Memorial

I. Organizer

2026 Czesław Cybulski Memorial, hereinafter referred to in these rules and regulations as the Event, shall be held under the patronage of the Mayor of the City of Poznań.

II. Date and venue

1. The Event shall be held on June 28, 2026, at 03:00 p.m. – 07:00p.m.
2. Athletics stadium in Poznań (Golęcin), ul. Warmińska 1, 60-622 Poznań.

III. Track and field events

1. Men: 200m, 800m, 1500m, 400m hurdles, pole vault, hammer throw.
2. Women: 200m, 800m, 1500m, 100m hurdle, 400m hurdle, hammer throw, high jump, long jump (national), 2000m hurdle.
3. Amateurs: relays 10x400m.
4. Children: 60m girls, 60m boys.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to change or introduce additional events.

IV. Terms and Conditions of Participation

1. Only competitors invited by the Organizer have the right to participate in the Event.
2. Competitors holding at least a master's class may register their willingness to participate in the competition until 06/18/2026 at 08.00 p.m., to the following email address: info@memorialcybulskiego.pl
3. The Organizer reserves the right to verify e-mail applications, select participants and determine the number of competitors in a given event, as well as the number of events to be held. Competitors who apply by e-mail to participate in the competition shall receive a confirmation e-mail stating that they have been selected to compete in the relevant event.
4. Failure to receive a response e-mail by 06/22/2026 at 08:00p.m. means that the competitor has not been qualified to participate.
5. The lists of competitors participating in the competition shall be published on the website of the meeting: <https://www.memorialcybulskiego.pl/> by 06/27/2026 at the latest.
6. The rules of the PZLA ('Rules of Athletics Competitions' Polish edition on the basis of World Athletics), World Athletics (<https://www.iaaf.org/about-iaaf/documents>) and European Athletics appropriate for events of the Continental Tour Label Silver category, are applicable in respect of the Participants.
7. The form entitled 'DECLARATION FOR TAX AND FINANCIAL SETTLEMENT PURPOSES 2026

AND DECLARATION OF PARTICIPATION IN THE SPORTS EVENT— 2026 CZESŁAW CYBULSKI MEMORIAL' shall be considered a declaration of participation' (Annex No. 1 to the Rules and Regulations).

8. By participating in the Event, the competitor declares that he or she has read the Rules and Regulations and agrees to observe them.

V. Financing rules

1. The Organizer covers the costs of organizing the Event.
2. The Organizer covers the participation costs of the invited competitors.
3. The participation costs of the remaining competitors are covered by their clubs or by the competitors themselves.

VI. Awards

Detailed information regarding the amount of the awards is set forth in the Annex No. 2 to the rules and regulations.

1. Winners of cash awards shall have income tax deducted in accordance with the mandatory provisions of the law.
2. Cash awards shall be handed over to the competitors only by bank transfer to a bank account specified by them. It is not possible to hand over the award in cash.
3. In order to receive the cash award to the bank account provided, the competitor is obliged to complete and service to the Organizer the necessary forms required by the tax office within 30 days from the date of the completion of the Event.

VIII. Overnight stays

The Organizer provides accommodation and board for invited competitors on 06/26/2026 (dinner), 06/27/2026 (breakfast, lunch, dinner), 06/28/2026 (breakfast, lunch, dinner), 06/29/2026 (breakfast) in the Novotel Centrum Hotel, pl. Władysława Andersa 1, 61-894 Poznań.

IX. Final provisions

1. Competitors participate in the competition with bib numbers assigned by the Organizer.
2. All competing athletes are required to have an up-to-date medical examination in accordance with current regulations of the Polish Athletic Association (PZLA).
3. A competitor confirms that he/she participates in the Event at his/her own risk and acknowledges that the participation in the Event involves physical exertion and involves natural risk and danger of accidents, the possibility of personal injury and physical trauma (including death), as well as damage and loss of property. Furthermore, the athlete has assessed the nature, extent and degree of risk involved in participating in the Event and has voluntarily decided to assume this risk by competing in the Event at his/her own risk.
4. It is forbidden to bring into the sports facility objects that can be dangerous to other competitors, including but not limited to drugs, doping, illegal substances and alcoholic beverages.

6. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or change the date of the 2026 Czesław Cybulski Memorial in case of force majeure events that may affect the course of the event. Force majeure in the meaning of the Rules and Regulations is any unforeseeable situation or event of an exceptional nature, beyond the control of the Organizer, preventing the fulfilment of any of the obligations provided for in the Rules and Regulations, not resulting from the error or negligence of the Organizer and remaining insurmountable despite exercising due diligence, in particular: natural catastrophic events such as floods, hurricanes, windstorms of extraordinary strength, tornadoes, earthquakes, unusually intense and prolonged downpours or extraordinary and external events that could not have been prevented (such as war, martial law restrictions, insurrection, revolution, riots, terrorist attack), epidemic threats, epidemic states, epidemics and states of epidemics, as well as new legal acts or decisions of administrative authorities preventing the Organizer from fulfilling its obligations. Neither the Organizer nor the competitors shall be liable for a failure to perform or improper performance of the provisions of these Rules and Regulations caused by force majeure.
7. The Organizer reserves the right to make amendments to these Rules and Regulations.
8. All disputes and organizational matters not covered by the Rules and Regulations shall be resolved by the Director of Poznań Sports and Recreation Centers (POSiR) together with the Competition Director.

X. Information clause

1. **Information regarding the Controller and the Data Protection Officer**

2. Purpose of the processing of Your personal data and legal basis for the processing

We shall process Your personal data, because You have signed up for a participation in the Competition. Your data shall be processed in order to conclude with you the contract on participating in the Competition and its performance on the basis of:

a) Art. 6 section 1 (b) of the GDPR* (processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract),

b) Art. 6 section 1 (c) of the GDPR (processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is a subject) in connection with the archive provisions applicable with regard to us.

If You have checked any of the consents in your sheet, your personal data shall be processed on the basis of Art. 6 section 1 (a) of the GDPR (the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes).

3. Recipients to whom we transfer Your personal data

In certain situations, we have a right to transfer Your data further (if necessary) in order to render our services. We may transfer Your data to the processors, with which we have concluded the contracts, in particular:

- on rendering servicing of the IT systems used by us,
- on using electronic mail servers and web sites (so-called electronic mail and web site hosting).
- on IT servicing of the competition, including, inter alia, time measurement,
- on damaging archive documents.

The aforementioned recipients are bound by the non-disclosure clause with regard to all data, including personal data, obtained in such circumstances.

The Polish Athletic Association (PZLA), bank in case of payment of the financial awards, insurers (in case You have an accident) shall be the recipients of Your personal data). Furthermore, if You have checked any of the above consents, the recipient of your data may be the owner of the Facebook social networking site on the terms in respect of data stipulated by Facebook available at <https://www.facebook.com/about/privacy>, the owner of the Instagram social networking site on the terms available at <https://help.instagram.com/519522125107875> and the owner of the X (formerly known as Twitter) social networking site on the terms available at <https://twitter.com/de/privacy> and the owner of YouTube service on the terms available at <https://policies.google.com/privacy?hl=pl&gl=pl>.

4. From whom we may receive Your personal data?

If You have signed up for the Competition through Aktisport Sp. z o.o., so we have received Your personal data through the intermediary of this company.

5. Period for which the personal data is stored

Having achieved the previously mentioned primary purpose, for which Your data has been collected, the data shall be processed for the archival purposes within a period compliant with the applicable archival law provisions. In case of checking any of the consents above, your data shall be processed until You withdraw Your consent to its processing.

6. Rights You have as the data subjects related to the processing Your personal data

You have a right to request us to get an access to Your data in order to amend and delete it or restrict its processing, as well as to object to processing and transferring Your data – pursuant to the applicable provisions.

You may withdraw your consent at any time, too. The withdrawal of your consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on this consent before its withdrawal.

You have a right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Protection of Personal Data Office related to processing Your Personal data, if the You consider that the processing of personal data relating to you infringes the provisions of the GDPR.

7. Obligation to provide data

Providing your personal data is a prerequisite for a participation in the Competition. You are obliged to provide it, and a failure to provide your data shall result in the inability to participate the Competition.

8. Transferring personal data to countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

We do not transfer your data outside the European Economic Area, subject to the transnational nature of the data flow on the Internet, including Facebook, Instagram, X (formerly known as Twitter), YouTube services. These services may transfer your data outside the European Economic Area, where other provisions on the protection of personal data apply.

9. Video monitoring

The video monitoring has been implemented for the purposes of ensuring security and property protection in the facilities of the Poznań Sports and Recreation Centers (POSiR).
